Bach Flower Remedies for Animals, by Stefan Ball and Judy Ramsell Howard, has been published as an eBook by Vermilion Books. It is the first of the core 'Bach Centre' books to be made available in this new format.

An eBook is a rights-protected, downloadable digital text file that has been protected against illegal copying. It can be read using any kind of digital platform – including dedicated eBook readers like the Sony Reader, PCs, laptops. Soon mobile phones will be eBook-enabled as well.

The new eBook is to be launched from Waterstones.com and other online retailers.
